## Free Top-Up Swimming Lessons Yr3-6

The sessions are provided to help children towards achieving the National Curriculum standards in swimming. The National Curriculum requires children to be able to swim 25 metres and to tread water for 30 seconds.

The sessions will be at Glass Mill Leisure Centre during the half term, Monday 29th May – Friday 2nd June. There are 4 sessions between 9am and 12pm. After you have applied you will be assigned a time slot. The sessions times are based on pupil ability, so it is important to attend the session you are allocated. You need to attend the same time slot daily for each session.

Please include the following:

- 1) Your child's name, School attended,
- 2) Year group,
- 3) Stage level of swimmer – ASA stages 1 – 7 or equivalent (if known),
- 4) Any medical information or special requirements.

If swimming ability is not known state appropriate description from below:

**Non swimmer** – no or limited previous swimming experience

**Beginner** – is confident in water but not quite swimming on front and back unaided

**Improver** – can swim on their front and back.

**Confident** – can swim comfortably on their front and back and in deep water.

## AFRIL Collection

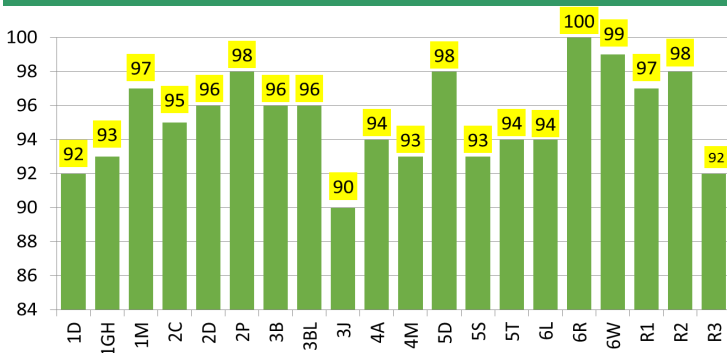

## Science Club

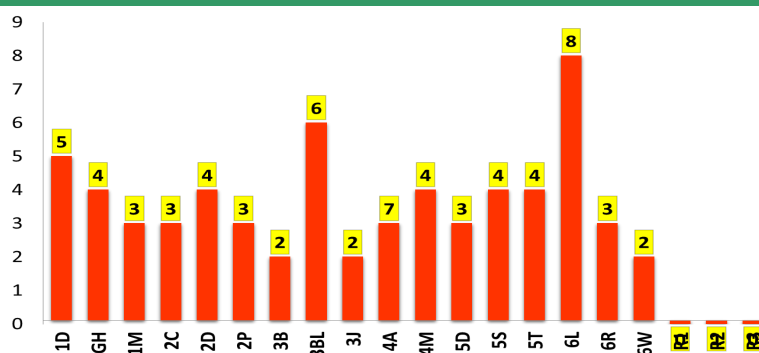
Science club will be starting after half term on Monday, 19th February.
