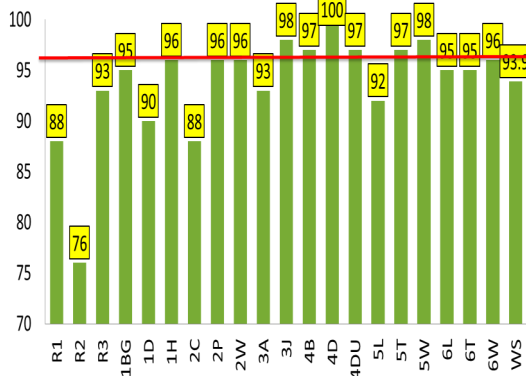
World Book Day - 2nd March

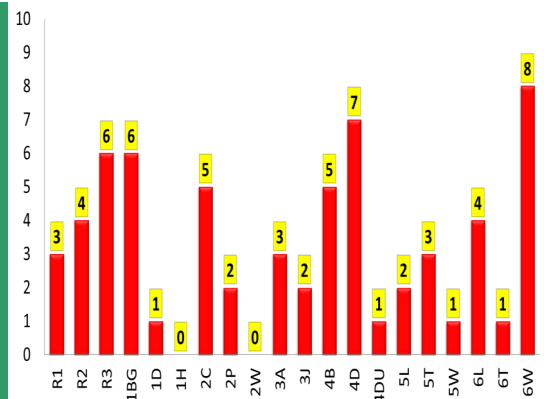
