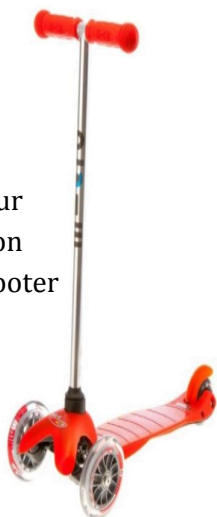
Please make sure that all club slips are returned to the school office by Monday, 26th March. If we do not receive your slip by this date, we cannot guarantee your child a place in their club of choice.

Illness

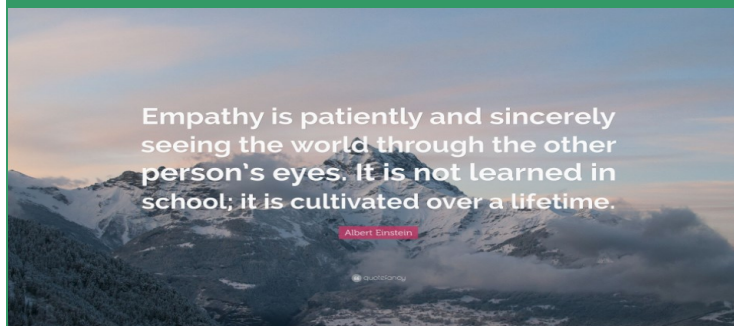
There has been a lot of diarrhoea and sickness within the school. Should your child be affected by either, they are not allowed in school within 48 hours after the last occasion of sickness. You will need to call the school on the absence line to inform the school on each day of your child/ren's absence. If they are absent for 3 days or more, we will require medical proof such as a doctor's note or a copy of their prescription so that the absence can be authorised.

Dinner Money

The dinner money cost for Summer 1 is £56.

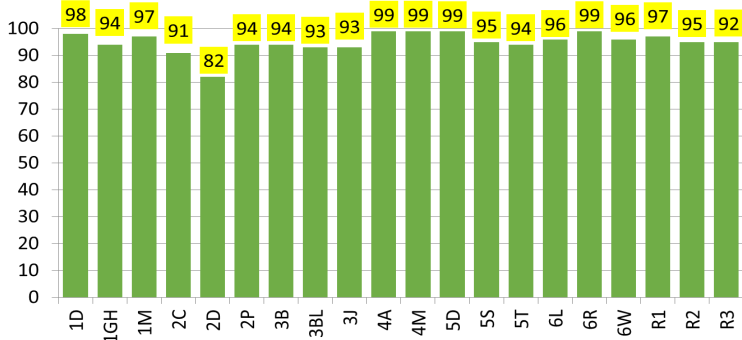

Care Club

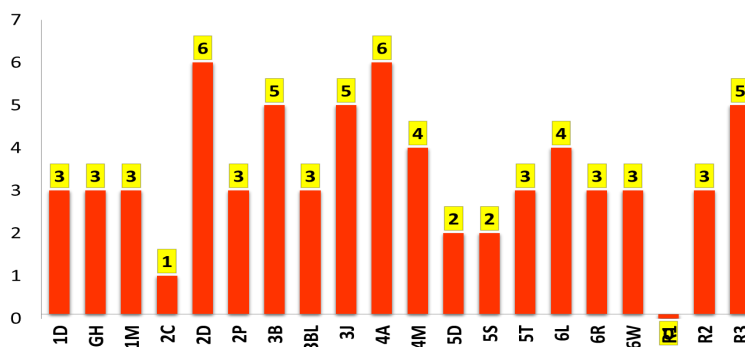

Pupil Premium Funding

Free school meals are part of something called '**pupil premium**'. As well as providing free school meals, pupil premium provides extra funding of up to £1,320 to your child's school. The school can then use this funding to support your child's education in various ways, e.g. extra tuition, teaching staff or after-school activities.

If your child is in Reception, Years 1 and 2 they are automatically eligible for Universal Infant Free School Meal. **However, you can still make a free school meals application and become eligible for pupil premium funding.**

For children in years 3 and above an application is required and if this is successful you could **save up to £400 a year.**

Families are eligible for free school meals if they receive one or more of the following benefits:

- **Universal Credit**
- **Income Support**
- **Income-based Jobseekers Allowance or Employment and Support**

Allowance

- **Child Tax Credit – net earnings threshold of £7400.00 from April 2018**
- **Guarantee element of pension credit**
- **Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999**

All applications for free school meals must be made online at www.lewisham.gov.uk/freeschoolmeals. To create an account please add the following information:

- Your full name and date of birth as registered with HMRC
- Your full address as registered with HMRC

Once you are registered an e-mail notification will be sent requesting you to verify your account and click on the link to access the online application. Once your application has been submitted and processed a letter will be sent to you advising you of the outcome of the application.
