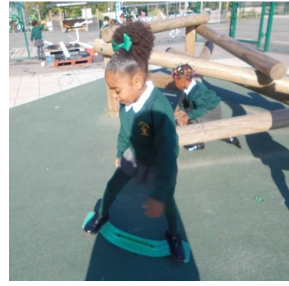


Harvest Festival
