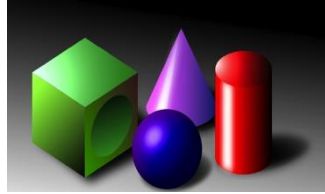


## Topics that will be covered this term;

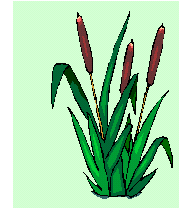
Our Topics for this term are:
