

## The Curriculum

Rushey Green School complies with all requirements regarding curriculum provision including the legal requirement to follow the statutory national curriculum as well as the requirement to make provision for a daily act of collective worship and teach religious education. In addition the school makes provision for personal, social, health, economic and citizenship education.
