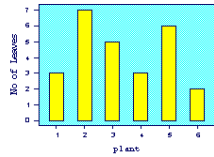


Topics that will be covered this term:



Numeracy

- ❖ Time (analogue and digital)
- ❖ Measurement Conversion
- ❖ Fractions

Literacy

- ❖ Classic Poetry linked to rainforests

Please check them regularly as the names can wear off.

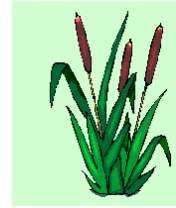
